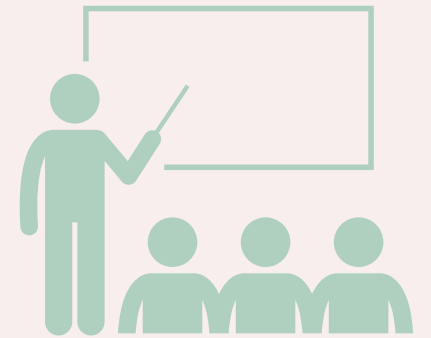

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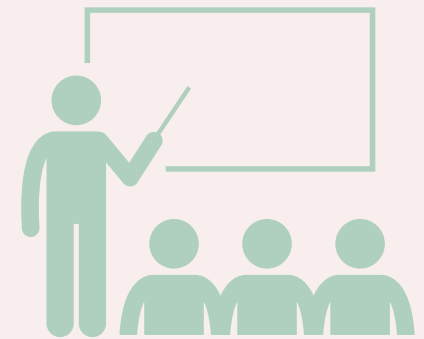

# What is Discover Articulation?

- Open to KS4 students
- Delivered jointly by the University of Leeds and the National Gallery
- Built on the success of the 6th Form Prize
- 2-3 minute film talking about a piece of art



# What is Discover Articulation?

- Individual or pair entries
- Maximum of 6 entries per school
- Students must be seen presenting and show the artwork
- Expressing opinions and engaging with art
- Having fun



# Why take part?

- Increase confidence in public speaking
- Develop skills such as research, team-work, time management
- Get creative with presentations
- Chance to talk about any piece of art that you want

- Host your own in school round





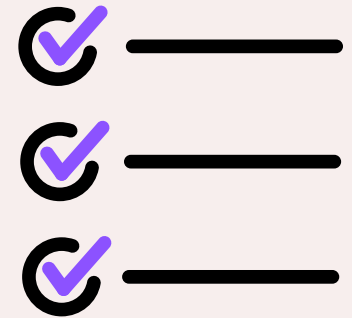
# Guidelines

- Videos should be 2-3 minutes long. For the on-campus final, presentations will be 5-7 minutes long
- Students should be seen presenting in the video, for pair entries both students must be seen
- You must show us the artwork you are discussing
- The presentation must reflect your own approach and personal response to the work of art



# How to enter

- Video entries must be submitted via We Transfer
- Teachers must have submitted the entry form
- Parents must complete the permission form
- We ask students to complete a survey prior to filming their entries
